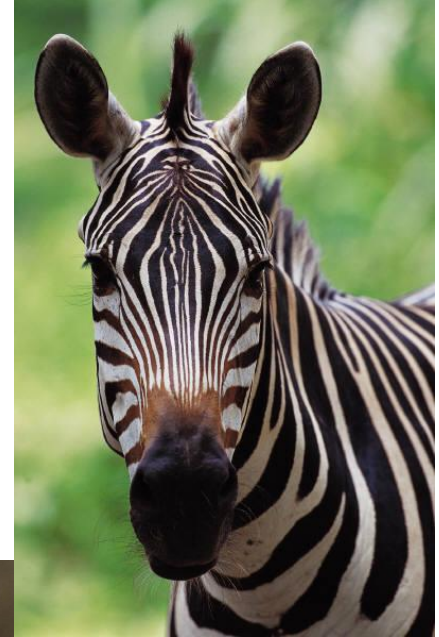
Grasslands

- The grasslands are a habitat that is covered with grasses.
- There are two types of grasslands; temperate and tropical.
- Temperate grasslands have a mild climate and four seasons.
- Tropical grasslands are located near the equator and warm all year round.



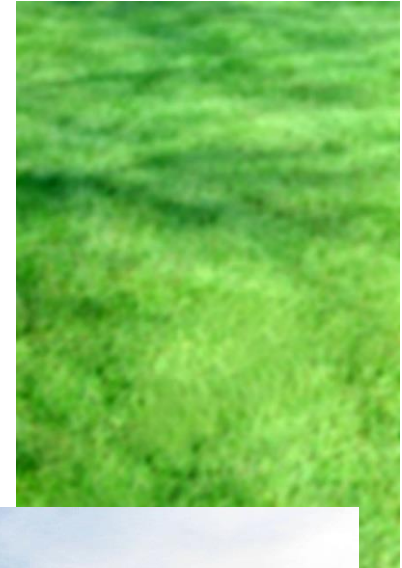
Animals

- Many animals that live in the grasslands.
- Many animals have *adaptations* to help them survive in this habitat. Example: flat teeth for eating grass, burrows so they can hide easily, and speed to catch prey.



Plants

- Grass is the main plant that grows in the grasslands. These grasses have deep roots to soak up water and nutrients.
- Few trees grow in this habitat. Trees that grow in the tropical grasslands have thick trunks to store water, and fire proof bark to protect them from wildfires.



VOCABULARY

- Temperate-an environment that has a mild climate and four seasons
- Tropical- an environment near the equator and is warm all year round
