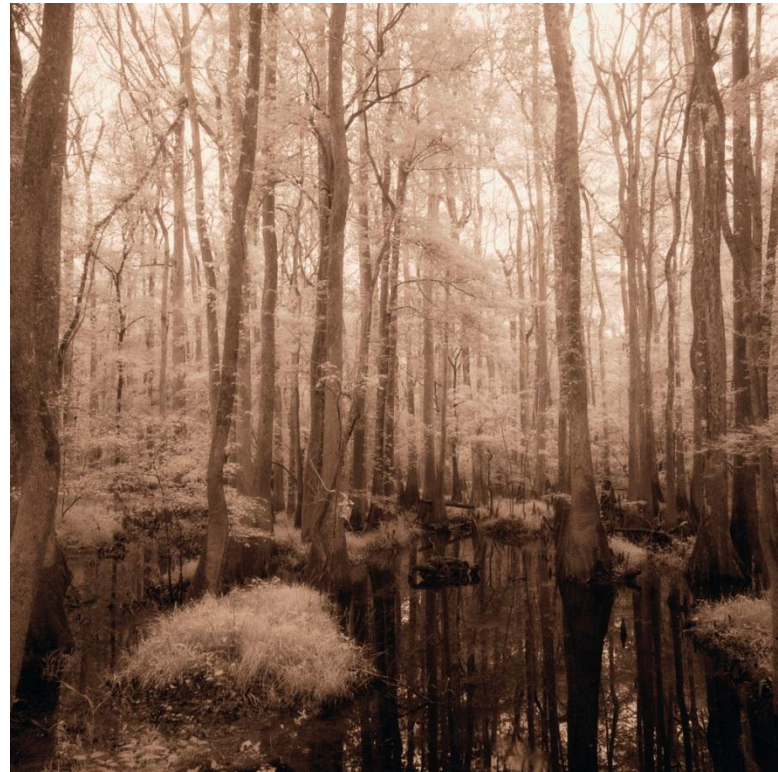


TEMPERATE FOREST



TEMPERATE FOREST

- The temperate forest is a habitat that has a lot of trees and four seasons.
- Soil in the temperate forest is rich in humus.
- Winters are cold and dry and summer are warm and wet.



Animals

- Animals in the temperate forest have adaptations that help them survive the changing seasons.
- Some animals hibernate to help them survive the cold winter.



Plants

- There are a bunch a different plants in the temperate forest.
- There are two different types of trees in temperate forests
 - deciduous
 - coniferous



VOCABULARY

- Deciduous- a kind of forest ecosystem with many trees that lose their leaves in the winter.
- Coniferous- a kind of forest ecosystem that stays green all year long.
- Hibernate- to rest or sleep through the cold winter
