Tropical Rainforest

- The <u>tropical rainforest</u> is a habitat that is located near the equator.
- Tropical rainforests have more living things than any other habitat.
- Tropical rainforests are hot and wet.
- Tropical rainforests can get anywhere from 80 to 180 inches of rain a year!



Animals

- Many animals that live in the rainforest swing, swoop, dart, and jump in the rain forest canopy.
- Many animals have adaptations to help them survive in the rainforest. Ex. Warning colors to warm predators to stay away, mimicry to help animals blend in.





- Tons of plants grow in the rainforest.
- Plants in the rainforest grow in four layers:
 - -emergent layer
 - -canopy
 - -understory
 - -forest floor
- Plants in the rainforest are adapted to grow towards the light.
